



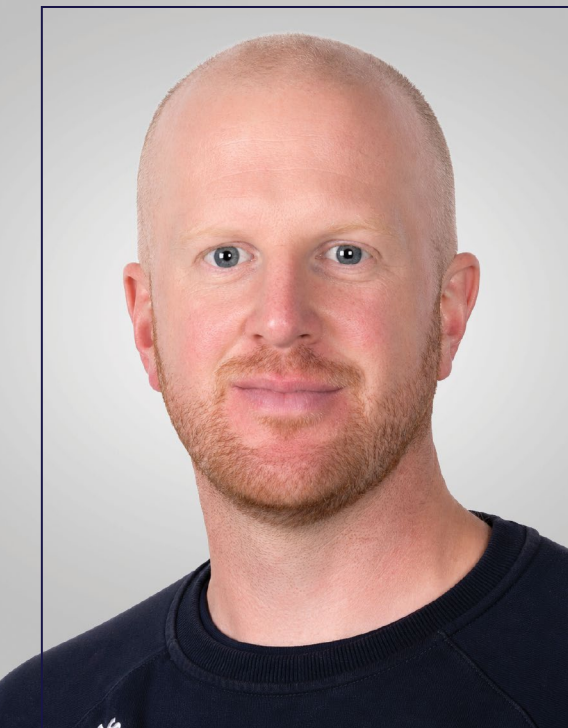

Sessions range from early-years music development (movement, play, and musicality for babies through preschoolers) to individual instrument and voice lessons including piano, violin, cello, guitar, ukulele, drums, saxophone, flute, and singing, alongside music theory. Students following the Musicville pathway can also work towards UK-accredited exams (ABRSM, Trinity College London, and Rockschoo), giving them a recognised, structured route to progress in music beyond the classroom.
